

Budgeting Services

The New Zealand Federation of Family Budgeting Services is a national network of budgeting services.

A budgeting service offers one-to-one advice to clients, individuals *and* families. The budget adviser will work with the client to establish a long-term, sustainable budget plan.

While they're working together, a budget adviser may advocate on behalf of their client, with government departments or other creditors.

Each year budgeting services see around 50,000 client families, so they are experienced in all sorts of budgeting issues, from quickly avoiding a crisis to insolvency procedures and long-term forecasts.

Budget advisers can be paid or volunteers, but all are trained to a high standard through the Federation of Family Budgeting Services. The Federation also has a detailed quality assurance program to make sure the advice being offered is always topnotch.
